At 22, Nan earned a second Bachelor's degree in Economics, and by 25, she founded her first music school—creating a nurturing environment where students could grow in both confidence and skill. Over the past nine years, she has taught piano, music theory, and music history, earning a reputation for her thoughtful, individualized approach to teaching.

Nan is currently completing her Master's degree in Piano Performance at the Katarina Gurska Conservatory of Music in Spain, studying under the esteemed pianist Gleb Koroleff.
